Application Guideline for SIT Scholarship for Doctor's Program

1. Purpose of the Scholarship

SIT Scholarship for Doctor's Program will be awarded to the SIT students in Master's Program, Graduate School of Engineering and Science, with the aim of promoting the enrolment to Doctor's program in SIT.

2. Eligibility

Applicants must be the SIT students in Master's Program, Graduate School of Engineering and Science and apply to enroll in Doctor's program in SIT with outstanding academic records.

3. Number of Awards

A few (planned)

4. Scholarship Duration and Stipend

- (1) Duration: 1 year (Maximum 3 years with an extension deliberation every academic year)
- (2) Stipend: (A) Full tuition fees for one year will be waived. / (B) Half of tuition fees for one year will be waived.
 - < Regarding concurrent receipt with other scholarships>

Concurrent receipt with other scholarships is not allowed.

However, concurrent receipt with 芝浦工業大学校友会大学院博士(後期)課程女性研究者育成奨学金 is permitted.

- ※In the following situations, the recipient may become disqualified for receiving scholarships
- (1) when the receipent is subjected to disciplinary action such as being expelled or being deregistered from the university
- (2) in the case of poor academic performance
- (3) when the false or fraudulent information was found on the application documents.

5. Scholarship recipients

- < Conditions for recipients of Scholarship (A) >*Both (1) and (2) must be satisfied.
- (1) Applicants must be the SIT students in Master's Program, Graduate School of Engineering and Science and will enter the Doctor's Program.
- (2) Applicants must have sufficient research achievements at the time of application for the Doctor's Program.
- < Conditions for recipients of Scholarship (B) >*Both (1) and (2) must be satisfied.
- (1) Female applicants who satisfy the criteria for Scholarship (A), but are not selected for recipients of Scholarship (A).
 - Female applicants who are eligible for the development of female researchers and engineers who are active in society

6. Application Procedure

- (1) Submission Deadline: No later than 4:00 p.m. (JST) on December 20, 2023
- (2) Application method:

Scholarship application procedures and required forms will be announced separately to applicants of Doctor's Program exam on Wednesday, December 6.

Submit the required application documents (documents of research achievements for scholarship /recommendation documents from professor) by the deadline in the designated method. (submit the documents via web or email.)

In addition, before applying, inform the outline of this scholarship and the recommendation documents you will need, to the supervisor who will recommend you.

7. Selection of Recipient

- (1) The selection committee will conduct a screening of the applicants and the president will decide the nominated candidates.
- (2) The recipients will be notified the result through TAO. (In later middle of February)

8. Continuation review

- (1) A continuation review will be conducted annually after acceptance
- (2) The following conditions will apply for continuation:
 - [Continuation Condition: Submission of one research paper*]
 - *Details and guidelines regarding the performance criteria for continuation will be provided at the time of acceptance.
