The workshop was held in Barcelona, Spain, for eight days from 10 September with the Faculty of Architecture of the Ramon Llull University.

In Barcelona, the participants conducted market research, which was their main task, and visited many architectures, including Gaudi's architecture, and were able to see examples of excellent conversions, especially in the contemporary architecture tour. The survey also covered the super block, pedestrian priority street project, and the courtyard regeneration project, both known as recent urban planning projects.

Six students from Ramon Llull University plus four international students from our university participated in the workshop, each presenting their architectural works and interacting with each other through discussions among students with diverse cultural backgrounds.

Furthermore, during the period, the students worked on a project to design a market in the Gracia district, and on the last day they gave a presentation, which was critiqued by the professor of the Ramon Llull university.
